

**Employees Classified as Primarily Instruction, Student Enrollment and Students per FTE  
ConnSCU Institutions, Fall 2010**

This table calculates student and faculty FTE for the purpose of generating ratios as 1 PT = 1/3 FTE. This method is used by the Common Data Set and has been adopted by IPEDS, although beginning in 2010 IPEDS allowed inclusion of administrators who teach classes also to be counted as FT faculty when institutions report ratios only to IPEDS. These administrators are not counted in this table below in order to provide consistent comparisons with 2002
